

Headwall hires Danjczek as senior advisor

NEW YORK — Steel industry veteran Thomas Danjczek has been hired as a senior advisor by corporate finance and advisory company Headwall Partners LLC, the company said on May 23.

Danjczek led the Steel Manufacturers Association (SMA) for 15 years until his retirement. Prior to joining the SMA he had been general manager of Wheeling-Pittsburgh Steel Corp.'s integrated steel mills and president of a Wheeling-Pittsburgh subsidiary. He also worked as a superintendent at Kaiser Steel Corp. and an engineer at Bethlehem Steel Corp.

"I look forward to working with Headwall's clients to deliver differentiated senior-level strategic advice," Danjczek said in a statement. "After several difficult years, the sentiment in the steel industry has turned far more optimistic, creating an opportunity for our clients to evaluate alternative strategies for growth."

Danjczek also served for five years as a board director for Globe Specialty Metals Inc. and GrafTech International Ltd. He still serves as director of Byer Steel Corp.'s board, and holds other current and former board directorships.
